

**THE NATIONAL AMATEUR RADIO ALLIANCE
DECLARATION OF PURPOSE AND ESTABLISHMENT**

WHEREAS, amateur radio has served communities, advanced technology, and connected people across the globe for over a century, and continues to provide vital public service through emergency communications, education, and scientific experimentation; and

WHEREAS, a significant number of licensed amateur radio operators in the United States are not affiliated with any national organization, representing untapped potential for community building and collective action; and

WHEREAS, amateur radio operators need modern resources and forward-thinking leadership that embraces both the traditions and the future of our service; and

WHEREAS, there exists a pressing need for community outreach to introduce amateur radio to new audiences, particularly youth and underrepresented communities, ensuring the continued vitality of our service; and

WHEREAS, emergency communications and public service remain core purposes of the amateur radio service, requiring dedicated programs, training, and coordination to serve communities effectively in times of crisis; and

WHEREAS, amateur radio spectrum and operating privileges face ongoing challenges from competing commercial interests, regulatory proceedings, and legislative action, requiring vigilant advocacy before the Federal Communications Commission, Congress, and other bodies to protect and advance the amateur radio service; and

WHEREAS, we recognize that multiple national organizations serving the amateur radio community create healthy diversity of perspectives, approaches, and advocacy strategies that strengthen the hobby as a whole;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that The National Amateur Radio Alliance was formed to fulfill these needs through:

- Education and Training** - Building operator skill, licensing pathways, and emergency-readiness competency.
- Community Engagement** - Building an active, vibrant community where amateur radio operators connect, collaborate, and celebrate their shared passion.
- Innovation and Modernization** - Embracing new technology and forward-thinking approaches within the tradition of the service.
- Outreach and Growth** - Introducing amateur radio to new audiences, particularly youth, and welcoming all who are interested in our service.
- Public Service** - Establishing and maintaining emergency communication networks and programs that serve communities in times of need.
- Advocacy and Representation** - Supporting efforts to protect and advance amateur radio privileges, spectrum access, and regulatory interests.
- Collaboration and Partnership** - Working alongside and collaborating with other amateur radio organizations, clubs, and national bodies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this organization shall be governed by:

- Democratic Principles** - With power vested in voting members who elect leadership, approve bylaws, and shape organizational priorities.
- Geographic Representation** - Ensuring all regions have voice and representation in governance through territory representatives.
- Transparent Operations** - Conducting business openly with clear communication, accessible records, and accountability to membership.
- Fiscal Responsibility** - Managing resources prudently with all funds dedicated to fulfilling our charitable mission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that membership shall be open to all persons interested in amateur radio without discrimination based on any protected characteristic:

Licensed Operators - Individuals holding a current amateur radio license issued by the FCC or a reciprocal licensing authority.

Aspiring Operators - Individuals working toward obtaining an amateur radio license.

Supporters and Friends - Individuals who support amateur radio without holding a license themselves.

Youth - Young people interested in exploring or pursuing the hobby.

Organizations and Corporations - Clubs, groups, businesses, and corporations that support our mission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this organization shall adopt comprehensive bylaws governing its operations, which shall be consistent with this Statement of Association and applicable law.
